Local Rules: (Penalty for Breach: Match Play - Loss of Hole; Stroke Play - Two Strokes).

- Movable Obstructions (Rule 24-1)**
Stones in bunkers.
- Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)**
When playing the 1st hole, a ball lying in the 'V' trench on the right of the 18th fairway may be lifted and dropped without penalty – not nearer the hole.
Immovable obstructions include the white stone left of the 9th fairway.
If a ball lies in or touches animal excreta, or when animal excreta interferes with the area of the player's swing relief may be taken. The fence between the 18th tees and the practice ground – relief to be taken in the designated dropping zone.
Relief may be taken if a ball lies off the putting green (but not in a hazard) and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and hole.
- Staked Trees and Staked Bushes - Play Prohibited**
If such a tree or bush interferes with a player's stance or the area of the player's intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure described in Rule 24-2b (immovable obstruction).
- Ground Under Repair (Rule 25.1) - Play Prohibited**
 - Newly laid turf and newly seeded areas (except divots).
 - Turf nursery between 4th & 15th hole.
 - The fenced area to the right of the 7th & 8th tee (Japanese knotweed).
 - White lined areas within heather plantations.
- Ground Under Repair (Rule 25.1) - Relief MAY be taken**
 - Areas encircled by white lines - see exception above.
 - Areas stripped of turf.
 - Tractor marks through the green.
 - The bunker to the left of 18th fairway (which is through the green).
- 5. Water hazards (Rule 26)**
The ditches on the left of the 1st, 6th and 18th fairways and the ditch on the right of the 7th fairway are lateral water hazards.
- 6. Out of bounds (Rule 27)**
A ball is designated OOB if it is through or over the boundary walls and fences of the course and through or over the length of fence which runs from the front of the 6th tee and behind the 5th and 15th greens. A ball is also OOB if it lies in or over the following 'V' trenches:
 - Back of 2nd green, Left of 5th fairway, Back of 8th green.
 - Between 9th and 10th holes (also applies when playing 11th hole). The start/finish of the trench between 9th and 10th holes can be determined by the line of sight from the white stone left of 9th fairway and white line on wall to the right of 14th fairway.
 - Right of 14th fairway including on or over the line of white bricks which run from the back of the 12th green to the front right of the 14th green bordering the path.
 - Right of 18th fairway (only when playing 18th); right and back of the 18th green; over the wall to the left of the 18th green, in the flower beds and on the putting green or surrounding paths.
